⁵You know we never used flattery, nor did we put on a mask to cover up greed – God is our witness. ⁶We were not looking for praise from people, not from you or anyone else, even though as apostles of Christ we could have asserted our authority. ⁷Instead, we were like young children among you.

Just as a nursing mother cares for her children, \$50 we cared for you. Because we loved you so much, we were delighted to share with you not only the gospel of God but our lives as well. \$Surely you remember, brothers and sisters, our toil and hardship; we worked night and day in order not to be a burden to anyone while we preached the gospel of God to you. \$10\text{You} are witnesses, and so is God, of how holy, righteous and blameless we were among you who believed. \$11\text{For you know} that we dealt with each of you as a father deals with his own children, \$12\text{encouraging, comforting and urging you to live lives worthy of God, who calls you into his kingdom and glory.}

¹³And we also thank God continually because, when you received the word of God, which you heard from us, you accepted it not as a human word, but as it actually is, the word of God, which is indeed at work in you who believe.
